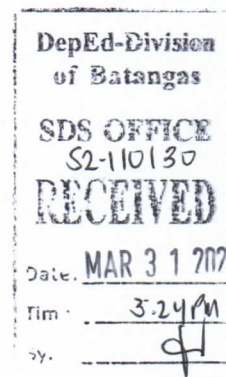

Jun headed the Multimedia Unit of ABS-CBN news that produced photos, videos, graphics and multimedia special reports for the network's news website. He is a Glory Award recipient, the distinguished alumnus award of the University of the Philippines College of Mass Communication.
